## Listen on Computer through iTunes

## To Open:

The USB port is hinged on the right-hand edge of the card. Just snap it open.



1. Insert the USB device into your computer. You'll be asked what to do with the new device.


Choose: "Open folder to view files using Windows Explorer"


2. For the purposes of this tutorial, we have plugged in "Rick's Picks" Flash Drive.

Double-click on the folder "Rick's Picks" to reveal the audio messages available on the flash drive.









\* It may take a few minutes for the files to copy from the USB device to your iTunes music library. Once they are finished copying, you no longer need to insert the USB device into your computer to listen to the messages; the files have been copied to your computer's hard drive.


1. Insert the USB device into your computer.

Double click on the folder that appears (in this case labeled "DISK\_IMG")




2. For the purposes of this tutuorial, we have plugged in "Rick's Picks" Flash Drive.

Double-click on the folder "Rick's Picks" to reveal the audio




3. Open **iTunes** on your Mac.

Click on the plus (+) sign (lower left of screen) to create a new **Playlist**.



Give the Playlist a name. Click "Done."



4. To move files from the flash drive to your new **Playlist**, highlight (select) all the audio files (located in your open DISK\_IMG folder) and drag them into your new **Playlist** folder in **iTunes**.



\* It may take a few minutes for the files to copy from the USB device to your iTunes music library. Once they are finished copying, you no longer need to insert the USB device into your computer to listen to the messages; the files have been copied to your computer's hard drive.
